## What is the purpose of this update?

### **Description of this fund**


Objective: to perform broadly in line with the return of its investment benchmark before fees and tax over the long-term.

Strategy: aims for high long-run returns by investing in a diversified portfolio weighted towards growth assets but with some income asset exposure.

#### What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Hunter Growth Fund<sup>1</sup>.



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

## Example of how this applies to an investor<sup>3</sup>


Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund when the fund received its first contribution, on 2 September 2020, and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the period to 30 June 2021, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,227 (that is 12.27% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total return after tax of \$1,146 for the year.


#### What does the fund invest in?

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> A combination of actual fund returns and market index returns have been used to determine the risk indicator as the fund has not been operating for the required five years. The risk indicator may therefore provide a less reliable indicator of the fund's future volatility. Market index returns have been used until 2 September 2020 and fund returns thereafter.
